The UAE SWAT Challenge's growth has been remarkable:



With over 100 teams already registered for 2025, the event continues to grow in scale, reputation, and inclusivity.










Dubai Police Teams Ready to Defend Their Title at UAE SWAT Challenge 2025

Lieutenant Yasser Al Zarouni, Manager of the Dubai Police tactical teams and leader of last year's champions, has confirmed the readiness of Dubai Police's squads for this year's highly competitive UAE SWAT Challenge 2025. Following intensive preparations and a focused training camp, the teams are determined to defend their title and maintain their dominance in the competition, which is expected to be more challenging due to the increased number of participating teams.



> Last Year's Success

In the 2024 edition, Dubai Police teams swept the podium, with Team Dubai Police B clinching first place in the overall standings with 325 points. Team Dubai Police A secured second place with 303 points, while Kazakhstan's Sardar Team claimed third with 302 points.

> This Year's Line-Up

Dubai Police is fielding an impressive six teams in this year's competition:

- · The two main teams, A and B

- Three teams from Dubai Police Academy

Returns Stronger Than Ever to UAE SWAT Challenge 2025

Kazakhstan is making its presence known at the UAE SWAT Challenge 2025, fielding an impressive 12 teams from various security and police agencies. Following their exceptional performance in last year's edition, where Team Sardar Kazakhstan clinched third place overall, the country is ready to elevate its game further.

> Leading the Pack

This year, Kazakhstan boasts the largest representation by a single nation, a testament to their commitment to tactical excellence. Rigorous preparations have ensured their teams are physically and tactically ready to take on the competition. From early training regimens to stringent selection processes, Kazakhstan's approach highlights their dedication to achieving greatness.

> Building on Last Year's Achievements

- Officer Rescue Challenge: Teams Sonkar and Sardar finished first and second, earning 73 and 72
 points, respectively.
- Tower Challenge: Team Sardar secured third place with 70 points, following Russia's Akhmat team and Kyrgyzstan's Kalkan team.
- · Obstacle Challenge and Tactical Competition: Team Sardar also earned third place in both categories.

These performances solidify Kazakhstan's position as a formidable competitor in the global tactical arena.

Both male and female members are competing, with each teamrigorously selected and prepared to show case their skills


> Proven Competitors

> Aiming Higher



The African contingent in this year's challenge includes:


- 2 teams from Rwanda

South Africa Showcases Tactical Expertise at UAE SWAT Challenge 2025




Building on Past Success

- Professionalism and coordination to tackle complex, high-risk operations.


> Continuous Growth in the UAE SWAT Challenge
